DIRECTIONS

From the North

Exit **M1 J27** and take **3rd exit** A608 towards Heanor.

Pass through Underwood and at T junction turn left. Stay on the **B600**.

After approximately 3 miles at Moorgreen, turn right directly opposite the **Horse & Groom Public House** (signposted to Eastwood & the Barber Sports Centre). Greasley Sports Centre is on the left after approximately ¼ mile.

From the South

Exit **M1 J26- IKEA Exit** and take **1st exit** A610 towards Ripley and Matlock.

After approximately 2 miles take the slip road signposted **Eastwood**. Keep in the right hand lane & take the **3rd exit** towards Eastwood. Go straight ahead at the **IKEA** roundabout and proceed up the hill. At the top of hill, just before the pedestrian crossing, turn right into **Dovecote Road** (look out for Sentry Home Improvements on the corner). Greasley Sports Centre is approximately ½ mile on the right hand side.

There is ample parking for up to 80 cars at the rear of Greasley Sports Centre.

Dogs may be walked in the adjoining public park and waste bins are provided!

12. **Best In Show:** The dog declared Best In Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show. Best In Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best of Sex providing they are unbeaten winning dogs. Reserve Best In Show must be selected from the Best Opposite Sex and the Reserve Best of Sex to the exhibit declared Best In Show. The dogs declared Best In Show and Reserve Best In Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition.

Withdrawal From Competition Dogs which become eligible for Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition other than breed Classes prior to the competition for Best in Show, as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog in competition for Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition.

Proviso: For the purposes of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be beaten dogs.

- 13 Exhibits will not be admitted to Best In Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- 14 No modification will be made to this schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 15 All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- 16 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.

17. **DOGS IN CARS**

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.

- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
- If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

Please take care of your dog.

If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Right to Refuse Entries. Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.

- 18 Not for competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club Registered
- 19 In the event of a Judge being prevented from fulfilling his or her engagement, the Committee reserve the right to appoint another in his or her place. Exhibitors may withdraw from competition but no entry fee can be returned
- 20 The Hon Veterinary Surgeon or Hon Secretary will be empowered to exclude any dog which in his opinion is not in a fit state for exhibition, either from disease or any other reason, and if such exclusion takes place either before or after the dog is judged, entrance fees will be forfeited.
- 21 The Committee will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog or dogs or property, whether arising from accident or any other cause whatever, nor for any act of omission of themselves, their officers, servants or others, and it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.
- 22 Should any question arise not provided for in these Regulations, the decision of the Committee shall be final, subject only to appeal to the Kennel Club
- 23 Exhibitors must provide drinking bowls and food for their dogs and are responsible for clearing up and removing loose hair or fouling from dogs in their charge. This also applies to any other litter, whether in the car park, exercise area or from any other part of the venue and its precincts. This is now a Kennel Club requirement and offenders may be reported for further disciplinary action. Please consider others and ensure that this venue is kept as clean and tidy as possible, and every facility will be provided for cleaning up any dirt left by your dog or yourselves

The Midland Afghan Hound Club cannot accept responsibility for products advertised or sold by stallholders at the show and remind exhibitors that grooming products on sale may not meet the requirements of the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition (Kennel Club Rule F(B)).

Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition F (Annex B)

1. These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition for any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee whose decision shall be final and may include reference for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.
2.
 - a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show.
 - b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition
3. No act or operation which alters the natural confirmation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
 - a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee
 - b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed
 - c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
5. Any individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate) to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.
